Roles & Responsibilities

Child Protection Case Conference (CPCC)

A (CPCC) is a formal part of the child protection process. This meeting should involve relevant family members and professionals to share and assess information and set out clearly defined plans to support and protect the child who is the subject of the conference. A CPCC can decide to place the name of a child on the Child Protection Register (CPR) or, in the case of a Review CPCC, to remove a child's name from the Register. Whenever a child's name is placed on the CPR, a CPCC must ensure that a Child Protection Plan is put in place.
