Roles & Responsibilities

Looked After Reviews

The LAAC Review plays an extremely important role in the development and implementation of the care plan for each looked after and accommodated child or young person. It is important that all staff and partners recognise the LAAC Review as a key component of care planning and ensuring quality outcomes for the child or young person - not just a process. The Team's core responsibility is to undertake a range of review meetings for children and young people who are looked after and accommodated and take an independent overview of progress relating to care plans for individual children or young people. The Review Team also has responsibility in the area of quality assurance and addressing multi-agency accountability. The Review Team also reviews kinship care placements prior to the locality team manager assuming responsibility.
