Tayside Multi Agency Public Protection Arrangements (MAPPA) is the process by which local agencies work together to best protect our community from the risk of serious harm that some offenders may still present after conviction. The main category of offenders are registered sex offenders and on occasion serious violent offenders. Key authorities involved are Prison Service, Police, Health Service, Criminal Justice, Housing providers and other statutory and voluntary organisations with a duty to co-operate
